



UST graduates successfully proceed to international schools in Tokyo and around the world, as well as Japanese private schools with international courses.



Admission Criteria

- English language proficiency
- Overall balance of nationalities, genders and academic levels
- Academic preparedness
- Positive attitude towards learning
- Commitment to international education
- Overall fit for the school's philosophy and culture
- Parents' language proficiency





Admission Priority



- Foreign nationals who are native speakers of English
- Near-native speakers who are transferring from other international schools
- Siblings of current UST students
- Foreign nationals with beginner level of English who demonstrate strong need for international education

Note: the same priority criteria will apply to students placed on the Waiting List.



Admission Procedures

- School tours and family interviews:
 - October-mid December
- Applications forms due:
 - by first week of January
- Screening and trials:
 - January mid March
- Acceptance announcements:
 - late March beginning of April
- Joining fees due date:
 - beginning of May
- Fall term tuition due:
 - beginning of June





Fees & Tuition

- UST's tuition is 50-60% of other schools
- Annual or termly payments
- Annual and sibling discounts
- Need-based scholarships available for elementary students
